Temporary ON-SITE signs may be permitted for grand openings or special occasions such as car, boat, or craft shows, carnivals, parking lot sales, annual and semi-annual promotions, or other similar events PROVIDED THAT:

- 1. A special occasion sign permit is issued by the Building Official.
- 2. The permit shall be for a period of time not to exceed thirty (30) contiguous days.
- 3. Signs shall be located on-site only and in such a manner as to not create any traffic or pedestrian hazard.
- 4. Animated, balloon, emitting, figure structured, or motion picture signs must be approved by the director of Community Development.
- 5. Signs shall be constructed and secured in accordance with all applicable standards.
- 6. Electric source must be at the location of the sign.
- 7. Balloons may only be permitted by a licensed contractor.
