at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.


Studies on file: February 2019 Speed Studies. The County-maintained streets within the Flamingo Bay Subdivision, an enclave, function as shared-use roads with significant on-road pedestrian, bicycle, golf cart, and vehicle activity. The home setbacks are minimal and no sidewalk facilities are present. Traffic volumes are relatively low and local in nature. The average speeds recorded were at 23 miles per hour with 85th percentile speeds at 29 miles per hour. Consistent with Florida Statute 316.189, a maximum 25 miles per hour speed limit is reasonable and appropriate for existing conditions within this residential community. Therefore, it is recommended that the posted limit of 30 miles per hour be lowered to 25 miles per hour.
