**I hereby direct that the** existing Stop signs on Douglas Avenue S. be reversed to the side-streets with Douglas Avenue S. designated as the preferential street

at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.

**Studies on file:** Request No. 46005. Field inspection of existing conditions on Douglas Avenue S north of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street SW to 15<sup>th</sup> Street SW revealed that road swales (dips) are in place on the north and south approaches at all intersecting streets up to 19<sup>th</sup> Street SW. The three study locations have previously had the north/south approach road swales piped and paved; thereby removing the basis for the current Stop controls. It is recommended that the Stops be reversed to comply with the MUTCD guidance to stop the minor street approaches. The intersection controls at the four intersections with road swales will remain as is until the County pipes and paves over the swales.
