Studies on file: John Morris south of Summerlin Road is the approach to a park that attracts significant pedestrian and bicycle traffic. This non-vehicular traffic shares the road and mostly operates in the wide paved shoulder on the west side of the road next to the travel lane. It is recommended that the speed limit be reduced to reflect the shared use nature of the roadway.
