I hereby direct that "No Parking" and "No Standing" prohibitions be established on the north side of Alico Road within the limits of the existing acceleration lane located west of the CEMEX Mine

at the above named location, in accordance with the attached detail.

This regulation shall be effective upon posting.



Studies on file: Field Survey of conditions on July 20, 2022 and emails with Lee County Natural Resources, Lee County DOT Operations, and CEMEX Staff. Trucks leaving the CEMEX mine are parking/stopping along the shoulder on the north side of Alico Road, which has caused damage to the edge of pavement and creates additional dust due to trucks dropping and driving through dirty on the shoulder. Due to the maintenance and environmental impacts of this behavior, a prohibition of Parking and Stopping is recommended.
