- Please see check-in table for pool schedule. Pool trips CX due to weather will not be made-up.
- On Pool & Water Days please pack bathing suit, towel, sunscreen.
- Crocs, sandals or flip-flops are allowed to & from Pool/Water Day ONLY.
- Counselors are not permitted to apply sunscreen on campers. Spray sunscreen is suggested.
- At the Pool, each camper must complete a simple swim test. Campers who no not pass may still swim with a life-vest on, provided by a life-guard.
- Ice Cream treats are available for purchase - \$1 each.
